E-Titling Discovery Phase 1

Phase 1 E-Titling Discovery continues with our partner, Deloitte. As we wrap up Phase 1 Discovery, we will continue working to understand fundamental E-Titling needs such as identity management, electronic dealer reassignment and proving vehicle ownership within the E-Titling sphere in preparation for drafting the Phase 2 Request for Proposal (RFP).

We will complete Phase 1 Discovery by February 15, 2024, with a completed statement of work (SOW) outlining the work required to implement E-Titling Phase 1. We'll meet with you virtually on **March 6 at 11:00 a.m. EST** to provide more details on our implementation strategy for Phase 1 and outline RFP activities for Phase 2, including a high-level review of our functional requirements. Be on the lookout for this invitation. It will include a comprehensive agenda so you can be prepared to discuss in detail.

Electronic Odometer Updates

The American Association of Motor Vehicle Administrators (AAMVA) has been working closely with the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) to better understand the regulations pertaining to electronic signatures on odometer disclosure statements. AAMVA has shared that they are presenting a proposal to their board of directors for review and hope to publish this information in the coming months. The content of this publication could have a significant impact on the process flow of E-Title programs around the country and as such, will be an important piece of our decision-making process.
