1. Progress report

- BMV is available for batch interface testing with providers as of December 1
- Distributed enrollment and implementation materials to Service Providers
- Began processing MOUS and enrollment applications from providers
- Wrapping up internal user testing
- Gearing up to train staff



2. Pilot Proposal Update

- Presented a proposal for piloting with providers and lenders at our last meeting in November
- BMV has since been in communication with Service Providers about the pilot and their development schedules
- We are updating the proposal based on those conversations

2. Pilot Proposal: What

Providers


- Requiring each service provider to do a one-month pilot after they have completed testing
- Asking providers to enroll 4 pilot lenders who meet our monthly volume criterion
 - Received a lot of feedback on criterion—team will review and follow up after holidays
- Successful completion = batch transactions consistent

Lenders

- Providers will enroll lenders from their client pool
- We have requested providers to include at least one ME lender in the pilot
 - We have some candidates from providers


2. Pilot Proposal: Timeline

- Our providers estimate beginning testing between late January and early March
- Once providers complete testing we can move towards bringing lienholders into the program
- At the moment, our timeline for the pilot is fluid
- BMV will communicate details about the pilot launch to our stakeholders—including the working group, dealerships, and lenders—in a timely fashion

3. Key Information for Stakeholders

- Lenders are eager to know who the state's approved providers are
 - We will make this information available on the website as providers complete testing
 - Expect to share in late Q1 or early Q2 (late winter or spring)



3. Key Info for Stakeholders (cont)

- Dealers and lenders may be expecting a list of Lienholder Identification Numbers in late January
 - We expect to post this list to late Q1 or early Q2 (late winter or spring)
 - They should leave the Lienholder Identification
 Number fields blank on title applications until the list is available on the website



3. Key Info for Stakeholders (cont)

- Some additional items:
 - We still want dealers and lenders to switch over to the new title application (MVT-2) in January, if they have not already
 - We are planning to offer our ELT trainings for dealers and lenders again in the new year
 - We will make a sign-up form available on our website.
